

## RECYCLING OPPORTUNITIES

**SACRA** - Donations of hygiene items such as toothpaste, toothbrushes, soap, deodorant, shampoo, etc. can be placed in the cart located in the Narthex on the 1st and 2nd Sunday of each month.

**VALLEY MISSION** - Donations of non-perishable food items can be placed in the cart located in the Narthex on the 3rd and 4th Sunday of each month.
